## HIGH SCHOOL SPECIAL ABILITIES ART SCHOLARSHIP COMPETITION • 2015-2016

**SUBMISSION DEADLINE: Friday, January 30, 2015**

The WSC Art & Design Department invites high school seniors interested in pursuing a degree in Art to apply for our Special Abilities Art Scholarship. Scholarships are awarded to incoming freshmen who have shown exceptional artistic merit at the high school level. Recipients of this scholarship must attend Wayne State College in the fall and major in art with a concentration in Studio Art, Graphic Design, or K-12 Art Education. Scholarships are awarded based on artistic ability, scholastic achievement, and letters of recommendation. Following selection, all entrants will be notified by mail.

### COMPETITION REQUIREMENTS:

#### I) Ten (10) high resolution jpgs of your artwork in any media

(jpgs sent on a CD or USB will not be returned and will become the property of Wayne State College.)

- When taking photos of your work use natural light (either indoors or outdoors). Place art work on a wall or easel and mount the camera on a tripod to avoid out of focus shots. All two-dimensional work must be photographed parallel to the wall, not at an angle. *These jpgs should accurately convey your artwork's color and value and be large enough to see detail.*
- Photos of sculptures need to include two to three views.
- Label jpgs numerically to correspond with the identification section on the application form.

#### II) Completed Art Scholarship Application form

#### III) Letter expressing your interest

Include why you would like to be considered for an art scholarship at Wayne State College. Identify art activities in which you have participated, your accomplishments in art, and your major goals in pursuing art.

#### IV) Two (2) sealed letters of recommendation

One letter of recommendation must be from an art instructor and another must be from a counselor or teacher.

#### V) Application packet submission

Either **MAIL** your entire application packet (jpgs, application, letter of interest and recommendation letters) to the
